- 1. Fill in the blanks of the change form. If necessary use additional $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ -inch sheet(s).
- 2. All submittals must be typed. Please use a 12-point font size. NSPC assumes no responsibility for unclear or illegible submittals.
- 3. Submittals sent via fax will NOT be accepted.
- 4. Changes may be submitted electronically in word processor format or via e-mail sent to white@naphcc.org prior to the cutoff date (see form).
- 5. To submit proposed changes, please use a separate form for each section. If you are proposing a new chapter or appendix, it should be submitted in its entirety, rather than each section separately.
- 6. If the proposed change conflicts with or changes other sections, please submit separate changes for all sections so affected. For example, if a code change affects a definition, the change to the definition shall be submitted on a separate Proposed Code Change Form.
- 7. Your proposed change must be based on the latest edition and must also reflect the actions of the most recent changes to the NSPC.
- 8. Please submit the code section or subsection to be revised in its entirety. Do not leave out unchanged paragraphs. Strike through all wording to be <u>deleted</u>. Underscore all wording to be <u>added</u>.
